OUR CLEANING PROCESS

Why is it important to clean your dryer vent annually?

Keeping your dryer vent clean is important for a number of reasons which include not only energy savings but safety.

A clothes dryer works by pushing out hot, moist air so your clothes can dry. If your dryer vent to the outside becomes blocked by lint, the air will not be able to expel the heat and moisture like it was designed to do. The result will be trapped moisture that takes more heat and energy to evaporate.



Signs that your dryer vent needs to be cleaned and inspected.

- Extended drying times.
- Clothing is hot to the touch but not dry after a normal drying cycle.
- The clothes dryer cabinet is hot to the touch.
- The dryer is starting to emit a burning smell.
- Excessive heat and humidity in your laundry area while the dryer is running.
- The air flow warning light is on.
- The exterior vent hood is not opening all the way or has lint collecting on it.
- It has been longer than a year since your last cleaning and inspection.

- The dryer exhaust specialist will begin by turning on the clothes dryer and locating the terminal cap where the dryer exhausts to the outside.
- The technician then begins cleaning the duct using a flexible rod system and an assortment of air-powered tool heads which spin and scrub the interior walls of the duct, loosening the lint and dust and extracting it outside at the terminal cap.



- After the duct is thoroughly cleaned from the outside the technician will then come inside and turn off the dryer and disconnect the transition duct from the rear of the clothes dryer. At this time the transition duct will be cleaned and inspected for any rips or tears.
- Bactronix service vans are fully stocked with clothes dryer vent replacement parts. If a system needs a replacement part, a price will be quoted.
- The technician will then connect a HEPA vacuum containment system to the wall inlet and put the vent system under negative suction while feeding the flexible rod system through the duct from the wall inlet to the outside terminal cap, which ensures the entire duct system is thoroughly clean.



- The transition duct is then reconnected to the dryer outlet and the wall inlet.
- At this time the dryer will be reset in place and cycled for proper operation.
- With the clothes dryer running the technician will then check for proper exhaust pressure at the terminal cap.
- An optional bird and pest guard can be installed at the customer's request to prevent birds and pests from making nests inside your clothes dryer and bathroom exhaust vents.



- Thorough cleanup of the jobsite is the final step of the process.
